COVID-19 AND INFECTIOUS DISEASE CONTROL RESOURCES FOR CRE PROFESSIONALS

The situation with COVID-19 continues to evolve quickly. Real estate professionals should check the latest information from authoritative health-related resources regularly.

CDC Resources

The CDC has released <u>interim guidance</u> for businesses and employers to plan and respond to COVID-19. The CDC has also built a website with details on how to <u>prevent the spread of COVID-19 in various communities</u> and a <u>website</u> with more extensive information on the disease. Additionally, the CDC has released <u>environmental cleaning and disinfection recommendations</u>. And the CDC has produced a <u>guide to hand washing</u>, which is helpful for staff and tenants. Individuals may also <u>sign up</u> to receive free CDC.gov email updates.

California Specific Resources

The California Department of Health has developed a <u>guidance page</u> for businesses and residents, it is being updated as new information is released by the State. The California Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (Cal OSHA) <u>website</u> lists several resources property and facility managers can utilize to prepare their buildings against COVID-19 and other infectious disease.
